It is hereby confirmed that the above-mentioned person was issued with a code 08 on 25 March 1981, which was converted to code EB on 20 December 2002. The driving licence was issued at Richmond Driving Licence Testing Centre in South Africa.

A code EB driving licence authorises the driver to drive a motor vehicle of the following categories:

A motor vehicle, excluding a motor cycle and motor tricycle being:

1. an articulated motor vehicle, of which the gross combination mass of the truck-tractor does not exceed 3 500 kilograms;
2. a combination of :
 - (a) a motor vehicle the tare which does not exceed 3 500 kilograms; or
 - (b) a minibus, bus or goods vehicle, the gross vehicle mass of which does not exceeds 3 500 kilograms;
3. a tractor or motor vehicle which is a type of mobile agricultural or industrial equipment or machinery not designed principally for the conveyance of persons or goods the tare of which does not exceed 3 500 kilograms


with a trailer. This includes an authorisation for a non-articulated motor vehicle, minibus, bus or goods vehicle, of which the gross vehicle mass does not exceed 3 500 kilograms without a trailer.

This driving licence was issued indefinitely **with no restrictions and is currently free from endorsements.**

The driving licence is valid for conversion to a driving licence of another country in terms of the United Nations Conventions on Road traffic (Vienna, 1968 and Geneva, 1949).

Proof of the South African driving licence is currently issued in a credit card format that expires every five years to ensure that the driver's photograph remains current and to ensure that the driver's eye sight did not deteriorate. The current card of this individual **expires / expired on 10 January 2028**. Kindly note the driving licences of the individual remain valid in South Africa even if the card expires. Mr [REDACTED] has therefore been in possession of a valid driving licence as from 1981 for a period of 43 years.
